

## **SOUTH OF BOSTON**

Take a day trip to explore South of Boston and experience the area's natural beauty along with international delicacies, soaring sculpture, and colorful urban art.

Considered one of the best Portuguese markets in the United States, you can stock up on specialty groceries and fresh meats, cheeses, and seafood along with a variety of home goods.

### New Bedford Public Art

## **National Monument to the Forefathers**

The largest solid-granite sculpture in the United States, this 81-foot-tall monument honors the Mayflower Pilgrims.

## **GREATER BOSTON**

Some of the most scenic sights in Greater Boston can be found in Boston's Beacon Hill neighborhood. Capture the gold dome of the magnificent Massachusetts State House and the expertly decorated window boxes of row homes dating back to the late 1700s and early 1800s. Be sure to stop at nearby **Acorn Street** – one of the most photographed places in Massachusetts – and stroll down Charles Street, which is lined with impeccably decorated storefronts. After that, wander down through the **Rose Fitzgerald Kennedy Greenway** to explore the seasonal outdoor art installations in Boston's Seaport neighborhood.

To get the best unobstructed views of the city skyline and Boston Harbor, head to **Piers Park** in East Boston or take the 30-minute ferry ride to **Spectacle Island**, and climb to its highest point. You can also hop aboard the 80-foot **Schooner Adirondack III** for sightseeing or sunset cruises.

## **Omni Boston Hotel at Seaport**

With 7 restaurants on site, this hotel in the heart of Boston's Seaport neighborhood is centrally located and walkable to picturesque harbor views and arts and culture exhibitions.

### **Revolution Hotel**

Housed in a former YWCA, this South End hotel celebrates the state's revolutionary spirit and history of innovation through its decor and original artwork – most notably, a 65-foot mural in the lobby by renowned artist Tristan Eaton.

## **NORTH OF BOSTON**

On the North Shore you can enjoy both stunning ocean vistas and sprawling historic estates. Gloucester's **Hammond Castle**, which sits on a cliff high above the Atlantic Ocean, was built by eccentric scientist and inventor John Hays Hammond, Jr., and features an eclectic mix of architectural styles. 10 minutes up the road in Rockport, you'll find sailboats bobbing in the water off the rocky coast, along with **Motif No.1**, a red fishing shack known to art lovers as a frequent subject of painters.

Head east to Ipswich where you can tour **Castle Hill at the Crane Estate**, a grand manor home sitting on 2,100 exquisitely landscaped acres that meander down to the sea, and soak up some sun on **Crane Beach's** four-mile sandy beachfront. If you have time, catch the sunset up the road at the **Plum Island Pink House**, but be sure to get there early to jostle for a good spot among all of the other photographers.

#### **VISIT THE TRUSTEES**

Journey up Argilla Road for an adventure at Castle Hill at the Crane Estate, the Inn at Castle Hill, and Crane Beach. These Trustees-stewarded properties are beloved by locals and visitors for their showstopping views, history, and Italian Renaissance Revival vibes.





## CENTRAL MASSACHUSETTS

As you stroll through the 200-acre **New England Botanic Garden at Tower Hill**, you can practice your close-up settings on hundreds of seasonal trees, flowers, plants, and herbs. To capture a stunning sunset, a perfect spot to set up is **Old Stone Church** in Boylston, which sits on the banks of the Wachusett Reservoir.

Worcester has amassed the largest collection of murals in New England – more than 100! – so if you're a fan of public art, you can easily spend an entire day tracking down these one-of-a-kind, colorful creations that proudly adorn businesses, schools, and other public buildings. When you're in the city, stop by the **Worcester Art Museum** and take in its famous collection of medieval armor – the second-largest in the Americas! Finally, wind down and catch the sunset at **Bancroft Tower**, a castle-like structure in Salisbury Park.



## **WESTERN MASSACHUSETTS**

Western Massachusetts not only offers impressive natural scenery but also picturesque gardens and stately homes. About 90 minutes northwest of Springfield is Adams, where you can take on 3,491-foot **Mount Greylock**, the highest peak in Massachusetts — on a clear day, you can see as far as 90 miles away. Don't worry, you can drive to the top if you're not up for the hike! Straight south, on the other end of the Massachusetts/New York border is **Bash Bish Falls**, a stunning series of cascades stretching nearly 200 feet high.

As for man-made beauty, **Naumkeag** is a grand 48-acre estate in Stockbridge renowned for its gardens and 44-room, "shingle style" mansion. A short drive north is **Ventfort Hall Mansion and Gilded Age Museum**, a Jacobean Revival-style mansion built in 1893 for Sarah Morgan, sister of J.P. Morgan – one of approximately 75 "cottages" built as Lenox was becoming a popular Gilded Age resort destination.

# **CAPE COD & THE ISLANDS**

There is no shortage of unique and memorable landscapes to capture on Cape Cod, Martha's Vineyard, and Nantucket. You can take in views of the ocean, forests, and salt marshes by foot or bike on **Shining Sea Bikeway**, a flat path that runs along the coast for 10.7 miles from Falmouth to Woods Hole. On the other end of the Cape, **Provincetown Dune Tours** can help you get off the road and into the protected dunes of the Provincetown Cape Cod National Seashore, which stretches for 40 miles along the edge of the Atlantic Ocean. Out on Nantucket, drive or hike up to the 109-foot peak of **Altar Rock** for 360-degree views of the Middle Moors, the island's largest undeveloped open space.
